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PROGRAM OVERVIEW

HOUSING

Emergency, transitional and permanent housing; move-in assistance; utility assistance; housing search; furniture and household goods.

COUNSELING & MENTAL WELLBEING

Individual and group mental health, post-traumatic stress disorder, substance abuse treatment and inner conflict.

CASE MANAGEMENT

Individualized case plans, goals, advocacy and benefits assistance.

CAREER SERVICES

Career center, job interview skills, job search assistance, resume writing, clothing and supportive employment needs.

LIFE SKILLS GROUPS

Culinary skills training, sobriety support, hiking, writing, motivation, meditation and art therapy.

TRANSPORTATION

Provide MARTA cards for transportation to VA & Healthcare appointments.

AFTERCARE

Case management to ensure stability in permanent housing inclusive of referrals to resources such as mental health, transportation and financial management.

ONE-STOP VETERAN SERVICES

Coordinated services through a network of agencies focused on veterans and their families, ranging from individualized case plans and advocacy to benefits assistance and legal services, and more.
